Haverhill Board Meeting Summary

From meetings on August 13 & September 10, 2009

From August 13 meeting:

Resident Questions/Issues: Concerns were heard regarding vehicles speeding throughout the addition — especially at entrances. Security has monitored speeds regularly, and ticketed where appropriate, but it is essentially up to residents to ensure that speeds are appropriate.

Board: Recruitment of new board members is critical— especially for check signing purposes.

Maintenance: Sidewalks throughout parks cleared of debris. Wood preservative applied to bridges. Paint touch-ups on mailbox posts completed. Sidewalk Repair: Sidewalk repairs have begun in several areas.

Treasurer: Treasurer will be obtaining estimates for lien proceedings against remaining homeowners with unpaid dues

Architectural: Gordon Vanderweele appointed as director of architectural committee.

Security: Juveniles congregating around addition remains primary complaint. Speeding continues to be a problem. Residents are urged to contact FWPD for all suspicious activity — this ensures that crime reports and statistics accurately reflect activity, and can result in increased patrols by city police.

Other Business: Bids for snow removal will be obtained. Based on the number of complaints received regarding city plowing, association anticipates contracting snow removal for the entire addition (last year, only side streets were contracted).

Watch Your Speed!

The speed limit throughout the addition is 30 MPH, but residents should be especially cautious at entrances and around parked cars where the street narrows and visibility may be low. Remember—our children are walking to and from school (and residents are getting their mail)!

Board: Judy Feichter was nominated and elected to serve as Vice-President for the remainder of the year.

Maintenance: Paint touch-up of association signage completed. Storm sewers in common areas have been cleared. Sandboxes in common areas are in need of repair or removal—board voted to remove these since usage appear to be low. Cost estimates will be obtained for replacement of swing structure in commons area west of Winterfield. Lighting: Entrance lights may be in need of replacement, based on age and frequency of repairs. Quotes will be obtained.

Treasurer: Properties with unpaid dues will be contacted one final time, to notify that lien proceedings will begin and attorney fees will be added to any outstanding dues amount. Treasurer will begin work on a proposed budget for fiscal year 2010.

Architectural: No architectural items to report. Dan Krieg appointed to serve on architectural committee.

Security: Residents are reminded to watch speed and obey stop signs throughout addition. Also, garage doors should remain closed when not in use.
